

POLICE & FIRE COMMISSION MEETING

February 16, 2021

1. Mr. Whitrock called the meeting to order and all members were noted present with the exception of Mr. Schlutter, who was excused.
2. Mr. Giese motioned, duly seconded by Mr. Flagel to approve the minutes of the meeting of December 15<sup>th</sup>. The motion carried unanimously.
3. There was no one present to address the Commission.

5. Upon motion by Mr. Flagel, duly seconded by Mr. Giese, the Police and Fire Commission voted unanimously to approve the vouchers.

Mr. Ault stated officers have been involved in multiple big incidents recently, this included assisting Kenosha with their riots, recent SWAT callouts and other high profile incidents in the Village. Mr. Ault also spoke about the COVID vaccine among staff and how the County as a whole is lacking with vaccine disbursement.

Mr. Deaver stated the FD came in second for the Red Kettle Challenge, bringing in \$2100.00. Mr. Deaver also stated EMS right now is training all online through Midstate because of COVID. Training preparations have doubled the amount of work, especially with new hired, during COVID. Building inspections have been busy, especially commercial inspections. Mr. Groeschel asked about anti-vaxxers and if their duties have changed. Both Mr. Ault and Mr. Deaver stated duties are not changing if employess choose not to get the vaccine.

Mr. Mahoney introduced Mr. Schaut as the new IT manager.

Mr. Flagel motioned, duly seconded by Mr. Giese to approve the Fire and Police Chiefs reports as presented. The motion carried unanimously.
